Exprim has been operating since 1999 and has kept growing ever since. Our reputation is based on our dedication and effort to satisfy the client.

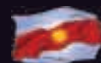

# Canning Stock Route



## In Brief

The Canning Stock Route...its name stays engraved in the exceptional memories of those who have had the chance to explore it, as it inspires all who have heard about it. It is today, one of the last lands for real adventure for desert lovers and passionate four-wheel-drive expedition enthusiasts.

*It is also one of the longest and most difficult adventures that Australia has to offer.*

An outback adventure through difficult terrain does not necessarily mean danger. This tour that Exprim offers is done with a certain comfort and in complete safety, with high-capability vehicles equipped with authentic camping gear (such as the comfortable roof tent!), all the necessary recovery, mechanical, navigation and communication tools (e.g.: HF, UHF, Satellite, GPS, ...), as well as food and drinks, and even the indispensable fridge; hence the guaranteed cold beer at the end of the day !



## Description

Built in the early 1900's by the road engineer A. Canning to drive livestock from the north of the state to the new gold fields in the south, this route spans two deserts and 1900kms, from Wiluna to Halls Creek.

The track used to be marked out by 51 wells securing water supply for cattle and men and we can still today discover the ruins. A few wells have restored by some 4wd associations (for who the Stock Route is a trip of a lifetime!). Among these water points, the well expected well number 23 which is the delivery point for the extra fuel necessary to continue the expedition.

All along the track you will discover the extreme diversity of sceneries that Western Australia has to offer:

Multiple bushes, salt lakes, hills and red ochre cliffs at dawn and sunset...

Eucalyptus forests sometimes not-so-easily crossed, underground caves with their mysterious aboriginal rock art and the colour palettes that the vegetation offers after the rains...

Many species of kangaroo (including the famous and rare 'Big Red') dingoes, camels, wild horses and a multitude of birds from the large emus to the gracious Australian bustard to the wide range of cockatoos, lorikeets and other parrots.



Leaving early from Perth, we will reach Kalgoorlie by late afternoon for a our first night and a quick look at the largest open cut gold mine in the world.

The next day, after filling up for the last time in Wiluna, the track awaits us and it is then a complete isolation with magical landscapes from the edge of the world. It will take us around 7 to 8 days to complete the first part to well number 23 where we will find plenty of water and the delivered fuel. It is another 5 to 6 days to well number 51, last well of the Canning Stock Route that we leave then at Billiluna to reach Halls Creek.

The grand finale is in Broome where you can relax a refreshing ice tea staring at the most famous sunset in the world!

The journey is designed for one vehicle with one or two passengers but can be done with two vehicles for three or four passengers.

The concept behind the tour remains the same as our individual tours and we offer total flexibility to suit your needs.

\*12 days= ½ Canning Stock Route, Perth / Newman / Perth.  
17 days= Full Canning Stock Route, Perth to Broome
